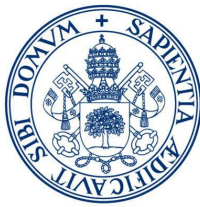

Admission requirements	<p>Once the students receive their selection e-mail, they will be provided with all the information about their admission process and they will be required to provide the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• National Identity Document or Passport (valid for the whole period of their stay)</li><li>• Evidence of B1 Spanish language level (diploma)</li><li>• Medical insurance, including repatriation and international medical evacuation costs (valid for the whole period of their stay)</li><li>• Learning Agreement filled in with the courses to be undertaken at our university. Find more information about available courses in the UVa official <a href="#">catalogue</a>.</li></ul> <p>Once the documents have been examined and validated, the student will be admitted and will receive his/her Acceptance Letter.</p>	

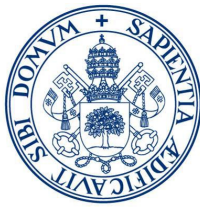

<p><b>Immigration procedures</b></p>	<p><b>Before arrival:</b></p> <p>Citizens of states not belonging to the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland must apply for a student visa.</p> <p><b>Upon arrival:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Citizens of member states of the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland must register at the Central Register for Foreign Nationals.</li> <li>• Citizens of states not belonging to the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ If their stay is of less than 6 months, they must register at the Central Register for Foreign Nationals.</li> <li>○ If their stay is of over 6 months, they must apply for a Foreigner Identity Card.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>More information about these procedures can be found at our <a href="#">Welcome Guide</a>.</p>
<p><b>Insurance</b></p>	<div style="display: flex; align-items: flex-start;">  <div style="flex-grow: 1;"> <p>For their temporary stay in Spain, students from the EU must get the <b>European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)</b> before leaving their countries.</p> <p>All exchange students/professors/staff visiting Universidad de Valladolid in the framework of any international mobility programme or bilateral agreement are required to have an <b>insurance policy</b> covering the following eventualities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accident</li> <li>• Illness (international medical evacuation inclusive)</li> <li>• Repatriation in case of death</li> <li>• Health insurance (if not eligible for a EHIC)</li> </ul> <p>The students/staff will present the insurance policy upon their arrival. The mentioned policy (or its corresponding official translation) is accepted in any of the following languages: Spanish (preferably), English, French, Italian and Portuguese.</p> <p>In case they do not have an insurance policy that covers the mentioned eventualities, Universidad de Valladolid offers the possibility of contracting a policy covering their complete period of mobility, regardless of its duration.</p> </div> </div>
<p><b>Mentor Programme</b></p>	<p>UVa offers one-to-one support to incoming students before and during their stay.</p> <p>To participate in the programme, students must select this option in their application process.</p>
