procedures	Citizens of states not belonging to the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland must apply for a student visa.			
	Upon arrival:			
	<ul> <li>Citizens of member states of the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland must register at the Central Register for Foreign Nationals.</li> <li>Citizens of states not belonging to the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland:         <ul> <li>If their stay is of less than 6 months, they must register at the Central Register for Foreign Nationals.</li> <li>If their stay is of over 6 months, they must apply for a Foreigner Identity Card.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Insurance	For their temporary stay in Spain, students from the EU must get the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) before leaving their countries.			
	All exchange students/professors/staff visiting Universidad de Valladolid in the framework of any international mobility programme or bilateral agreement are required to have an insurance policy covering the following eventualities:			
	<ul> <li>Accident</li> <li>Illness (international medical evacuation inclusive)</li> <li>Repatriation in case of death</li> <li>Health insurance (if not eligible for a EHIC)</li> <li>The students/staff will present the insurance policy upon their arrival. The mentioned policy (or its corresponding official translation) is accepted in any of the following languages:</li> <li>Spanish (preferably), English, French, Italian and Portuguese.</li> </ul>			
	In case they do not have an insurance policy that covers the mentioned eventualities, Universidad de Valladolid offers the possibility of contracting a policy covering their complete period of mobility, regardless of its duration.			
Mentor Programme	UVa offers one-to-one support to incoming students before and during their stay. To participate in the programme, students must select this option in their application process.
