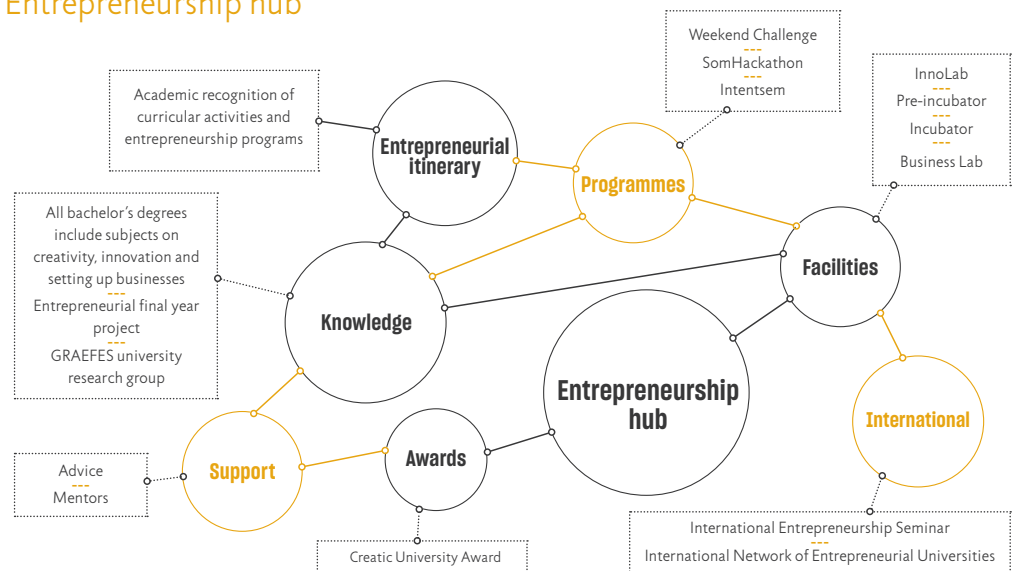

Medical Insurance

The Spanish government and European Union have made it compulsory for all foreign students to have health insurance for the entire duration of their studies.

Students from EU partners have to present the European Health Insurance Card. It is essential that the Insurance Card is valid for the entire study period.

Students from Non-EU partners need to take out a health insurance policy that covers the entire study period.

Academic prerequisites

Students should be aware of the prerequisites for the selected courses. If the prerequisites for a course are not met, students will not be able to enrol on that course.

Class attendance

Students are expected to attend all lectures and seminars. For some courses, attendance is compulsory.

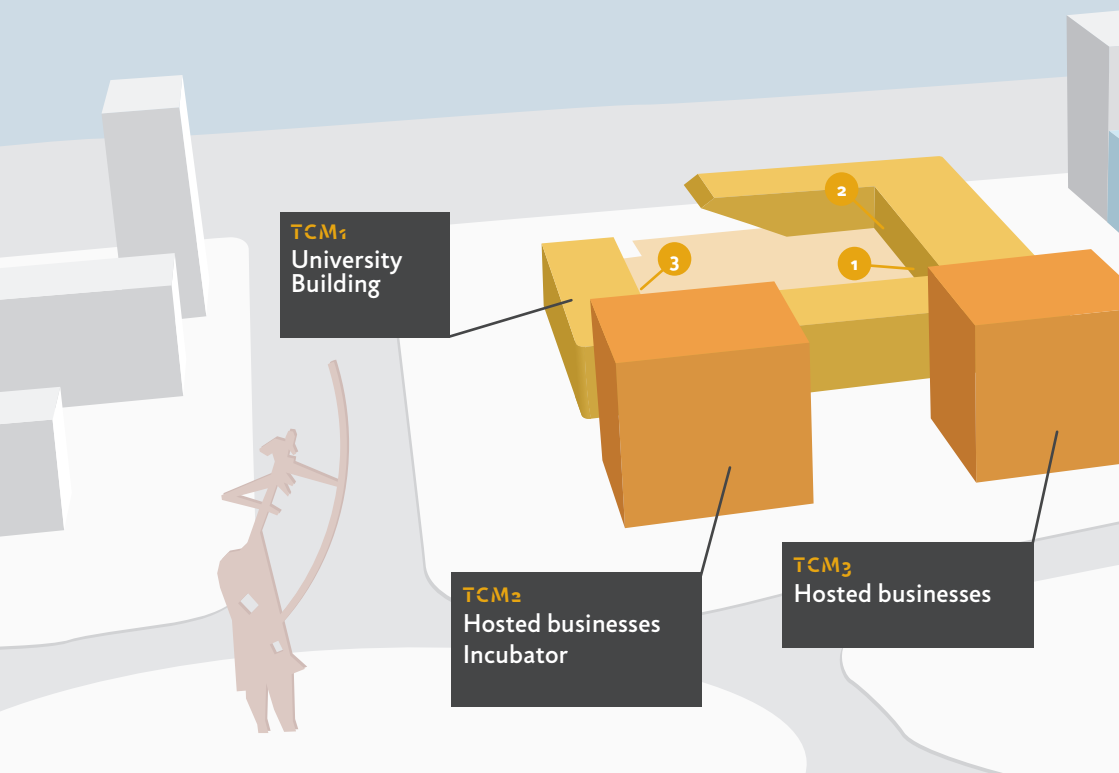

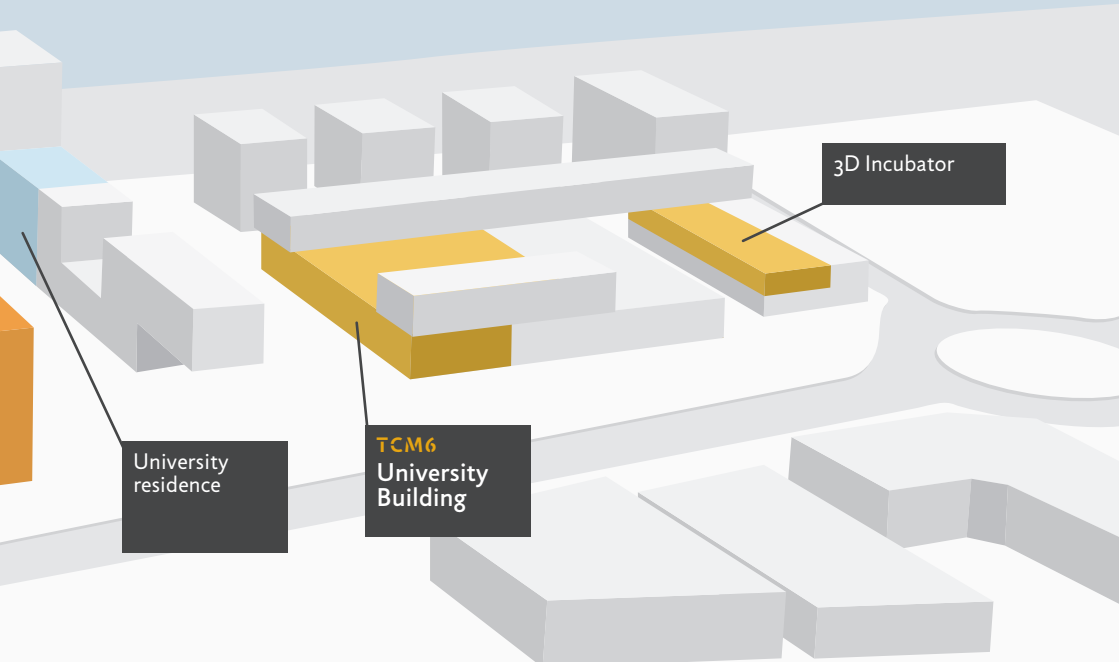

Registration

Upon arrival, international exchange students are welcomed in the International office of during the Welcome day. Each incoming student is enrolled as a student in TecnoCampus and receives the credentials for the virtual campus by email.

Registration in Mataró or Barcelona

Regardless of where you come from, you will have the option to register through our International Office. Please send us an email at rrii@tecnocampus.cat and we will help you with that.

We recommend you to start before your arrival.

If you wish to do the registration by yourself you will find indications, depending on your nationality:

European citizens

All EU citizens residing in Spain for a period **exceeding 90 days**, must apply for registration in the Central Registry of Foreigners. This registration leads to a certificate of registration being issued and includes a **NIE number**.

You must apply for this document directly at the police station (it is required to arrange an appointment on the Sede electrónica website):

Mataró residents

At the Police Station located in Avinguda Gatassa, 15 (902 24 73 64).

Barcelona residents

At the Police Station located in Rambla Guipúscoa, 74.

If you do not fall into any of these categories, just go to the Spanish consular representation in your country to be informed about the legal requirements to entry and study in Barcelona. You can find all the up to date information on the website of the Ministry of Interior's website.

Students from outside the EU

Once in Barcelona, international students are encouraged to register their contact details to their Embassy or Consulate in Spain.

If you are a student from outside the European Union (EU), the EEA (Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway) or Switzerland, in order to stay in Spain legally for more than 90 days, you need to obtain a student residence authorisation, which authorises you to remain in Spain for the duration of your course and if you wish, you will also be able to travel within the EU and the countries that have signed agreements with Spain or the EU for the free movement of people.

Accommodation

Atenea Living

Atenea Living is located next to the University Campus, within 2 minutes walk, and in front of the sea. It has a total of 86 beds and students can apply for one if their stay is going to be of 10 months or less.

The residence is fully equipped. On the ground floor there is the cafeteria with kitchen service and outdoor terrace, the laundry room and the personal area. On the first floor there is a multipurpose room, study rooms, coffee corner, dining room and games area. On the next floors are the bedrooms composed by 40 individual bedrooms, 20 double bedrooms and 2 triple bedrooms. On the rooftop there is the terrace with solarium and the swimming pool.

Mataró city

Mataró is the capital and largest town of the Maresme region with a population of over 120.000. It is located on the coast, between Cabrera de Mar and Sant Andreu de Llavaneres, about 30 kilometres north-east from Barcelona.

The town's main feature is its large port, which is one of the most important on the Maresme coast, and it also has a number of large city beaches.

The coastal N-II highway follows the same path as the original Roman road and nearby are the archaeological remains of the Roman villa of Can Llauder.

Mataró is famous for so many activities you can join. The main points to meet with friends are: the beach, the mall, or the main city centre street called La Riera, where you can find lots of shops, cafes and many restaurants. Of all the things to do, the thing you cannot miss is the nightlife. Mataró has a party area near TecnoCampus where you can go out to clubs like Cocoa, Miracle, Classic or Clap.

Barcelona city

Barcelona is the capital of Catalonia with a population of 1.6 million inhabitants (3.2 million inhabitants adding the metropolitan area). Its excellent location on the shores of

the Mediterranean, its gentle climate and its open cosmopolitan character make the Catalan capital an extraordinary place to live.

It is currently recognized as a global city due to its importance in the spheres of culture, finance, business and tourism. Its port is one of the foremost in the Mediterranean and the city is a transport hub between Spain and France.

Harmoniously integrating tradition and modernity, Barcelona combines the architectural evidence of its Roman and Medieval past with both Modernism (Catalan Art Nouveau) –with Gaudí as the leading exponent of this architectural style– and gems of contemporary architecture such as the Agbar Tower. Its gradual evolution has made it a focal point for architecture lovers.

Barcelona, the Southern Gate to Europe, hosts one of the largest university communities in Europe, made up of 200.000 students and more than 15.000 professors in seven universities offering a wide range of undergraduate and postgraduate programmes.

Its potential has made it a magnet for new trends from around the world. Design, music, fashion, art and cinema professionals are part and parcel of this dynamic city. A broad offer in culture, sports, and leisure and nature activities rounds out the spectrum of opportunities. A perfect place to combine quality academic activity with a good social life.

Transport

TecnoCampus is located in the city of Mataró, only 30 minutes away from Barcelona Centre.

From Barcelona to Tecnocampus

By train

- Take the train line R1 or RG1 (stations in Barcelona: *Sants-Estació, Plaça de Catalunya, Arc de Triomf, E* / *Clot-Aragó*) to Mataró station.

Some trains terminate at Mataró train station and others at *Blanes, Maçanet-Massanes, Calella* or *Arenys de Mar* – but all of them stop at Mataró.

By bus

- You can take the “Casas” bus number E11.1 in Barcelona (it stops in Ronda Universitat, 21 or Plaça de Tetuan):
E11.1 – Barcelona – Mataró (centre)
- E11.2 – Barcelona – Mataró (Nord)

You also have night buses:

- N80 – (Barcelona – Mataró)
- N82 – (Barcelona – Mataró – Pineda)

By car

- 1 From Barcelona, head North on the C-32 Motorway towards Mataró/Girona
- 2 Leave the motorway at the exit “Mataro Sud” (about 25 minutes from Barcelona)
- 3 You will come to a large roundabout with a huge metal sculpture, take the 2nd exit
- 4 TecnoCampus will be just in your right



TIP

We suggest you to buy a multi-journey ticket for 10 trips (T-Casual 3 zones), valid for train and buses to Mataró, and train, buses, tram and metro in Barcelona. You can buy this card in the metro, railway stations and newsagents. You can find all the type of tickets here: tmb.cat
