Postgraduate Program Digital Enterprise Management



For an effective "Digital Transformation" of organizations, which can benefit from sophisticated technologies such as "cloud computing", "big data & analytics", "internet of things", 3D printing, "machine learning", or artificial intelligence, among others, and in a more accessible way, there is still a lack of managers or staff members with skills that allow approaching the implementation of these projects in a holistic and strategic way and not just as a technological modernization.

The Postgraduate Program in Digital Enterprise Management aims to prepare managers and professionals for digital and business transformation, not only with the knowledge of the latest technologies available in an information management perspective, which is increasingly complex, and which allows for the creation of strategic and competitive, as well as managing this transformation that involves a whole set of factors such as the preparation of the organizational culture, management of change, valorization of human resources, redefinition of processes, and creation of value.

Goals

This postgraduate program aims to:

- Prepare managers to be in charge of the "digital transformation" in their organizations, and become the change drivers in processes, organization and human resources;
- Help in the selection and prioritization of the adequate technological solutions and distribution models to accelerate the profitability and productivity in the organizations;
- Offer the students clear access to state of the art of reference suppliers of technologies and distribution models that leverage the digital transformation;
- Provide access to digital transformation methodologies, and maturity models, that allow the readiness assessment, and management of an organization transformation.

Who is it for?

The Postgraduate Program in Digital Enterprise Management is aimed at managers and professionals who wish to deepen their project management skills in business transformation, based in new digitalization models and information systems. Among the potential candidates we highlight the 1st and 2nd level managers of medium-sized and big enterprises, systems integrators and consulting companies, and IT and IS professionals.

MANDATORY COURSE UNITS

To earn the postgraduate program diploma, students have to complete 60 ECTS, of which 45 in mandatory course units. The remaining 15 ECTS correspond to the elective course units, chosen by the students from a wide range of course units (please see them at www.novaims.unl.pt/DEM) and can be from the Fall Semester and/or the Spring Semester.
